### SCOTT-BAYSHORE INTERCEPTOR REHABILITATION

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Scott-Bayshore Interceptor Rehabilitation will be received by the Green Bay Metropolitan Sewerage District, at the Green Bay Metropolitan Sewerage District Office, 2231 North Quincy Street, Green Bay, Wisconsin, until 2:00 p.m., Local Time on the 3rd day of August, 2017, at which time the Bids received will be opened and read aloud. Any bids received after the specified time will not be allowed or considered. The Project consists of constructing:

The Work of this Contract is generally described as rehabilitation of the existing Scott-Bayshore Interceptor sewer and manholes from manhole SBS 29 to manhole SBS 37. Small sections of interceptor pipeline at Meter Station 14 and 15 will be rehabilitated with a shortliner. Existing lining material will be removed at existing laterals from a previous rehabilitation project upstream of MH SBS 37. In addition, protective cover over the interceptor sewer will be added at three locations where the existing cover material over the sewer has eroded. A driveway will be constructed to serve as access during construction and also future permanent access.

**LEGAL PROVISIONS:** The Contract letting shall be subject to the provisions of Sections 60.77, 66.0901, and 779.15 of the Wisconsin statutes.

**WAGE RATES:** Prevailing wage rates are not required for this Project.

**AWARD OF CONTRACT:** Any contract(s) awarded under this Official Notice to Bidders must demonstrate positive efforts to utilize Minority and Women's Business Enterprises (MBEs/WBEs) and other Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs). The Green Bay Metropolitan Sewerage District encourages MBEs, WBEs, and DBEs to submit bid proposals.

PRE-BID CONFERENCE: A **mandatory** pre-bid conference will be held prior to the Bid opening on July 20, 2017, at 2:00 p.m. at the Green Bay Metropolitan Sewerage District Office, 2231 North Quincy Street, Green Bay, Wisconsin, to familiarize Bidders with this Project.

BID SECURITY: Bid Security in the amount of not less than 5% of the Bid shall accompany each Bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

CONTRACT SECURITY: The Bidder to whom a Contract is awarded shall furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in an amount equal to the Contract Price.

BID REJECTION/ACCEPTANCE: The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, waive informalities in bidding, or to accept the Bid or Bids, which best serves the interests of the Owner.

BID WITHDRAWAL: No Bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the scheduled opening of the bids without the consent of Owner.
